UPDATE TO MEASURES FOR FLIGHT AND CABIN CREW WHO ARE NOT SINGAPORE CITIZENS, PERMANENT RESIDENTS OR LONG-TERM PASS HOLDERS

1 In view of the latest developments related to the 2019 Novel Coronavirus, this circular updates the measures with respect to flight and cabin crew.

2 Flight and cabin crew of all airlines, who are not Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents or long-term pass holders, with recent travel history to mainland China¹ within the last 14 days will not be allowed entry into Singapore or transit through Singapore².

3 Paragraph 2(c) of CAAS Circular 2020/2 and paragraphs 3 and 4 of CAAS Circular 2020/3 therefore no longer apply to flight and cabin crew of all airlines, who are not Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents or long-term pass holders.

¹ For aircraft that is transiting in mainland China before continuing on its flight to Singapore, a member of the crew who does not disembark from the aircraft (unless for the sole purpose of carrying out external checks of the aircraft) is not deemed to have travelled to mainland China.

² A member of the crew who does not disembark from the aircraft (unless for the sole purpose of carrying out external checks of the aircraft) is not deemed to have entered into Singapore or transited through Singapore.
